I would think that cuttings would have to be taken no later than the end of July to be ready in time. Many of you will have received Michael Drake-Brockman's email about this but if anyone is able to grow a few early cuttings or help out for a few hours at the Fair then please let us know. The AGM is coming up in September and then the Distribution Day in October. As we have had several new members join during the Show please make a special effort this year to make extra plants so that there will be plenty to go around. If you desire a particular variety then why not contact someone that you know has it, as at the Distribution Day it may be in short supply.

Our Facebook page is up and running and there are plenty of photos. If you join the group then you can post your own photos as well. Ivor Mace, the champion UK grower, has a Facebook page where he regularly posts photos of his year in progress and I am sure that our members will be interested in the progress of each others plants.

Start planning for your season ahead. It is nice to set yourself a goal and work towards it.

## Cultural Notes

Following up on the last newsletter and the use of the growth regulator Paclobutrazol I can add the following. For exhibition and large decoratives the results were very encouraging. An increase in petal number and size was achieved. This could have been helped by the fact that the blooms were first crown and most were crown buds. The results were not so good for the anems, singles and spiders where the increase in petal numbers adversely affected the form of the blooms. Look after your plants and you will have some nice cuttings for late August! Ed.
