## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CLASSIFICATIONS

### **Large & Medium Exhibition: (Sections 1 & 2)**

Provided that the form of the cultivar is either incurving or reflexing, or any variation of these two forms, and can reach 175mm or over it is classified as Large, or 150mm or over as Medium Exhibition.

### **Incurved: (Section 3)**

Cultivars are firm, neat and globular. Florets are close together and the visible parts, in most cases, point upwards and inwards in tight formation. Florets close over at the top of the bloom without any pit or depression.

### **Reflexed Decorative: (Section 4)**

Florets generally turn outwards and downwards. There are two types; one with neatly reflexing florets, and the second with stiff, spikier florets not forming a smooth shoulder, but developing blooms with a generally reflexing form.

### **Intermediate Decorative: (Section 5)**

Blooms that are neither fully incurved nor reflexed, but somewhere in between. The most usual type being the open loosely incurving form. This Section also includes blooms loosely incurving in the upper parts and with reflexing lower florets.

### **Anemone-centred: (Section 6)**

Blooms have a dome-like cushion in the centre that is surrounded by one or more rows of ray florets. Some have florets that are broad, flat and even in length while others have sharply pointed florets, uneven in length.

### **Single: (Section 7)**

Simple, daisy-like flowers with up to five or six rows of florets radiating from a central disc.

### **Pompon: (Section 8)**

These have short tubular florets. A well grown disbudded bloom can be likened to a golf ball.

### **Spray: (Section 9)**

Smaller flowered cultivars exhibited as the terminal growth of a stem bearing a cluster of blooms from which the apical bud may be removed. They should be capable of producing a minimum of four blooms per stem but more than twenty may be seen on some cultivars. A wide variety of bloom types is acceptable but they should generally present as a smaller version of forms seen in other Sections

### **Fantasy: (Section 10)**

Florets are long, narrow and tubular. Spiders (Section 10a) have hooks or coils at the tips of the florets whereas those of Quills (Section 10b) are straight to their ends.

### **Any Other Type: (Section 11)**

Cultivars with blooms not conforming to other sections. For example: Edo – twisted florets forming a tangled bloom, Ichimonji– large flowers with a single row of wide concave florets, Mino – broad petalled semi-double blooms reminiscent of a waterlily, Saga –narrow erect florets producing a bloom resembling a brush or thistle, Spoon – a single bloom with petals quilled at their origin resembling a spoon or paddle.

### **Miniature: (Section 12)**

Very small flowered cultivars. Charms (Section 12a) have short, freely branching stems whereas Cascades (Section 12b) have longer and more flexible stems enabling easier manipulation to various plant shapes.

## Notes

1. Bloom sizes given under “Classifications of Sections” are based on what a normal grower in a normal year should expect. Where a bloom is presented for judging which is larger than its classification no penalty should be applied. Conversely, where a Large or Medium Exhibition bloom is presented below the indicated minimum size it should be regarded as inferior.
2. Where blooms of a cultivar are consistently found to be either larger or smaller than their classification in a majority of states then they should be re-classified.
3. Other Colours indicates a cultivar that has bloom colour that is inconsistent with the common classifications. For example- amber, maroon, orange. It also includes cultivars with blooms of more than one colour.
4. Cultivars classified as Intermediate Decorative (Section 5) may also be shown in classes for Incurved Decorative (Section 3) or Reflexed Decorative (Section 4) when they have been grown so that the blooms are of true Incurved or Reflexed form. However, cultivars classified as Incurved (Section 3) or Reflexed (Section 4) may not be shown in Intermediate Decorative (Section 5) classes. The show’s Chief Steward must be informed so that judges can be briefed that the bloom(s) are to be judged according to the requirements of a Section 3 or Section 4 bloom as appropriate. It is to be noted that some of the Section 5 cultivars in this Register were formerly registered as Section 3 in one or more of the state based registers that preceded this one.
5. Virtually any cultivar may be grown in spray form and, if of sufficient quality, may be exhibited in classes for Sprays. In particular, many Pompones (Section 8) cultivars are capable of producing good exhibition Sprays. However, a Section 9 Spray cultivar is bred and registered specifically for this purpose. There are some cultivars that are commonly grown in spray form, but when disbudded have the requisite size and form of another Section and should be registered in that other section.
6. An occasional cultivar may have the general bloom form of a Fantasy (Section 10) but not strictly conform to the description of either a Spider or a Quill due to the petal ends having alternate forms. In addition there are a number of cultivars found in old registers which were classified as Section 10 only. Many are now extinct and so a sub-section cannot be ascribed. These are all now registered as Section 10 without sub-section.
7. Any Other Type (Section 11) contains sub-sections for recognised bloom types that historically have been less commonly grown in Australia. Many of them are of Japanese origin. Spoon type cultivars are classified Any Other Type (Section 11f) as while they have quilled petals in common with Fantasies (Section 10) they are single blooms whereas Fantasies are doubles. They are also distinct from Singles (Section 7) due to their quilled petals which are regarded as a fault in that section. A sub-section, Unclassified (Section 11a), is also included to allow the registration of cultivars that are either of a type not yet recognised as distinct in the Australian classification system or cultivars that have unique characteristics that are regarded as sufficiently meritorious. There are some cultivars that were registered as Section 11 without further description in the registers that preceded this one. Where their specific type is unknown they have been included in Sub-Section a.
8. Miniature (Section 12) cultivars are classified for their small bloom size. Sub-Sections a and b relate to their growth habit. Where a miniature cultivar does not conform to either the Charm or Cascade growth habit but is otherwise of sufficient quality to merit registration it may be registered as Section 12 without specifying a sub-section. As an example this situation might apply to cultivars best suited to growing in bonsai form. Any pleasing bloom type is acceptable but single and anemone forms predominate.

The following tables are indexed by Alphabetical order, Class order and Colour order to assist members in making their selections for propagation and showing. This should especially assist new members to gain familiarity with cultivars, and choose their favourite colours to grow in all classes.
